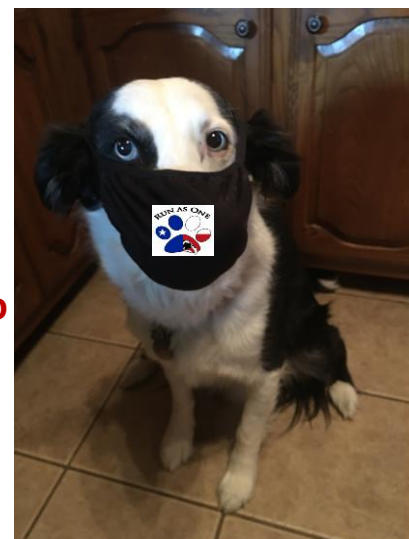

No Day of Show Entries. If this changes Day of Show minimum \$20 per run.

Refunds:

No more refunds will be made for entries withdrawn after the closing date. Rare exceptions and with fees deducted. In the event that the trial cannot be held for reasons beyond the show committee's control, efforts will be made to at least partially refund after covering our expenses. We are one of the few clubs known for never intentionally short changing anyone.

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th places in all jump heights in all classes. Ribbons will be awarded for those achieving a qualifying score. Rosettes will be awarded for those finishing 'select' titles. There are no placement ribbons for Chances as it is pass/fail. **Note: A five point Q is allowed in the Regular class in both Skilled and Proficient.**

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a minimum \$35.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <http://nadac.com/afirm/dogregfrm.asp> A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but it cannot be used during your run, nor can you indicate to the dog it is there. Only Intro and Novice handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
 - 1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
 - 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
 - 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
 - 1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), Run As One Agility LLC (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and OK Corral Ranch & Arena (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons
-

- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions by handlers at all times.
- Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the Agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in control will be excused from the Agility trial. Any owner, handler, or spectator exhibiting poor sportsmanship or abuse towards a dog or person will be required to leave the show site for the duration of the trial without refund.
- **ALL FOOD AND TOYS MUST BE CONTAINED AT THE TRIAL AND NONE CAN BE LEFT LYING ABOUT LOOSE**
- All dogs must be on leash or securely crated when not in the ring.
- Run As One Agility LLC may refuse any entry for many reasons. Anyone not currently in good standing with Run As One Agility will not be allowed to enter the trial (this includes outstanding returned checks or prior entry unpaid cancellations). Also Run As One Reserves the Right to refuse entry for prior acts of Unsportsmanlike Conduct, Mean or Rude Behavior, Aggressive Dogs, Cheating, and other reasons without recourse.
- Entries must be made on the enclosed entry forms. Copies may be made. **No other forms will be accepted.**
- Entries must be signed and be accompanied by the correct entry fees to be valid. Entry forms must be completely filled out and legible. **Fees Must Be Received with Entry prior to Closing Date.** No refunds after closing date.*
- Dog sales or puppies under eight weeks old are not permitted on the trial site.
- **NO SOLICITATION OF ANY KIND is allowed without prior written approval of Run As One Agility Show Chairperson.**

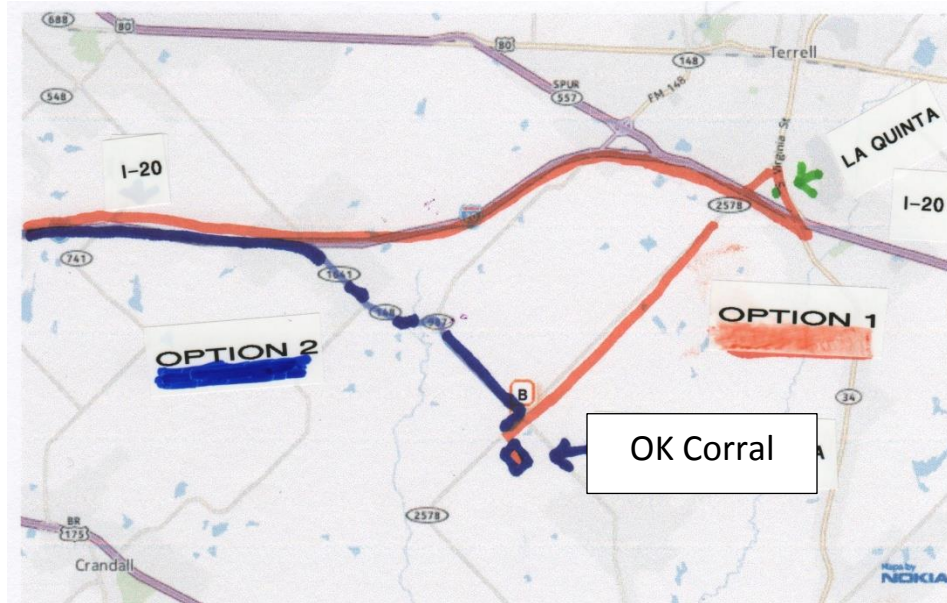

Option 1) I-20 East toward Terrell. Exit # 501 North (cross over 1-20). ~1/4 mile Just past hotels look for FM 2578. Turn left and drive ~4.3 miles to OK Corral Ranch & Arena on the left. Look for our sign.

Option 2) I-20 East Exit #493 slight right onto FM 1641 then drive ~1.2 miles to FM 148N then 1.2 miles to FM 987 N and Turn Right. Drive another 2 miles to FM 2587. Turn right on FM 2587 then go ~ .3 miles to OK Corral Ranch & Arena. Look for ours sign.
